



A) Ten feet from backboard = in bounds for object ball at start of frame and foul line for pointing and shooting (hitting, spoking).

3.05m (10 feet) from backboard equals inbounds for pallina at start of frame and foul line for pointing and shooting (hitting of spocking).

B) Thirty feet from backboard = center court line. Object ball must pass this point at start of frame.

9.15m (30 feet) from backboard equals center-court line. The pallina must pass this point at the start of the frame.

C) Same as "A" above.

3.05m (10 feet) from backboard equals inbounds for pallina at start of frame and foul line for pointing and shooting (hitting or spocking).
